Prior to joining Public Strategies, Fuller served in the Bush Administration as the Chief of Staff at the Consumer Product Safety Commission and most recently as the Chief of Staff at the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) within the Department of Homeland Security. While serving at TSA, Fuller served on the Agency's Leadership Council overseeing all major policy issues and was instrumental in eliminating a significant backlog of persons seeking redress with the terrorist watch lists and reducing the total number of persons on the TSA selectee list.

Raised in New Mexico, Fuller worked for U.S. Senator Pete Domenici of New Mexico as his political Director and as Legislative Assistant where he monitored and developed legislation regarding commerce, economic development, telecommunications, transportation, space, and small business issues. Fuller also served as the state director for Bush Cheney 2000 and has led several statewide political campaigns, including Senator Pete Domenici's successful 2002 reelection effort.
